Sunday, September 10, 2017. Opening ceremony 1:30 PM at Washington Hebrew Congregation, 3935 Macomb St. NW (street parking available). Check-in and resource fair beginning at 12:30 PM.

There will be two service projects along the route. The first is apple bagging in conjunction with The Society of St. Andrew in Virginia. It will be hosted by Annunciation Roman Catholic Church (3810 Mass Ave. NW). The second will be decorating reusable napkins for donation at the Apostolic Nunciature to the United States (3339 Mass. Ave. NW).

Each house of worship will have its own programming including a demonstration of religious rituals, a tour of the building, an offering of traditional foods, and an introduction to the religion and its practices.

Closing ceremony, 4:30 PM at the Islamic Center of Washington, 2551 Massachusetts Ave.
