Under consideration at the DC Council this Tuesday, December 4.....

As DC moves to implement a Supreme Court decision that allows cities and states to **collect sales taxes on all online purchases, the \$20 million in newly generated revenue should go to meeting the urgent needs of DC residents - housing, child care, schools and healthcare....**

The Council in its vote next Tuesday should **reject the proposal** that the new revenue be used **to cut taxes** for the District's largest commercial properties, those worth \$10 million or more.

This decision will reflect whether the **Council's commitment to inclusive growth** really means sharing the city's prosperity by helping residents get a home, a good education, and job training so they can afford to live here and prosper in their community. [Read more](#)
